**Independent Contractor:
The Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects**

Embassy of Japan in Yangon is seeking for qualified Myanmar nationals for ONE position (Engineer) for independent contractor for the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects at the Economic and Development Cooperation Section.

Basic Function of the Position

Tasks as an independent contractor include;

- Consulting with applicants,
- Managing the progress of ongoing projects,
- Submitting necessary reports,
- Arranging ceremonies of projects,
- Conducting pre-survey of applied projects, mid-term monitoring, completion monitoring and follow-up monitoring of ongoing projects,
- Reviewing the projects from technical point of view.

Required Qualifications - What We Expect

- At least a Bachelor's degree (Degrees on engineering).
- Minimum five years of working experience.
- Computer literacy including Microsoft Word, Excel and Power Point.
- Excellent English skills both in speaking and writing.
- Good interpersonal and problem solving ability.
- Japanese language ability (if possible).
- Previous working experiences at NGOs or other similar experiences as GGP (if possible).

Contract Term

From June 1 2023 to March 31 2024. The contract can be extended up to three years on yearly basis based on the performance.

Required documents are;

- A Curriculum Vitae (CV) with a photo,
- A Cover letter which explains your motive to this position and what you have achieved in your previous work, with two contact information of your former superiors,
- A Bachelor’s or Master’s degree certificate,
- A Grade report of your degree,
- An official English test score, such as TOEFL and IELTS (If not available, please attach something instead which can prove your English proficiency),
- Any other documents that can support your ability (such as Japanese language test score).

Note: Please make sure that you have attached all of the required documents listed above to your e-mail. Shortage of necessary documents may be regarded as disqualified.

Deadline of Submission

Wednesday, March 1, 2023

Note: Only short listed candidates will be contacted for the next process by March 14. There will be a writing test and an interview for those candidates at the Embassy of Japan.

About Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Project (GGP)

The Japanese Government offers financial assistance for various projects throughout Myanmar.
