The Programme for Emergency Food Assistance to Displaced Persons in Rakhine, Kachin and Northern Shan States (Coordination with WFP)
(Up to JPY 1 billion)

To provide rice, beans, and other food to displaced persons in those states.



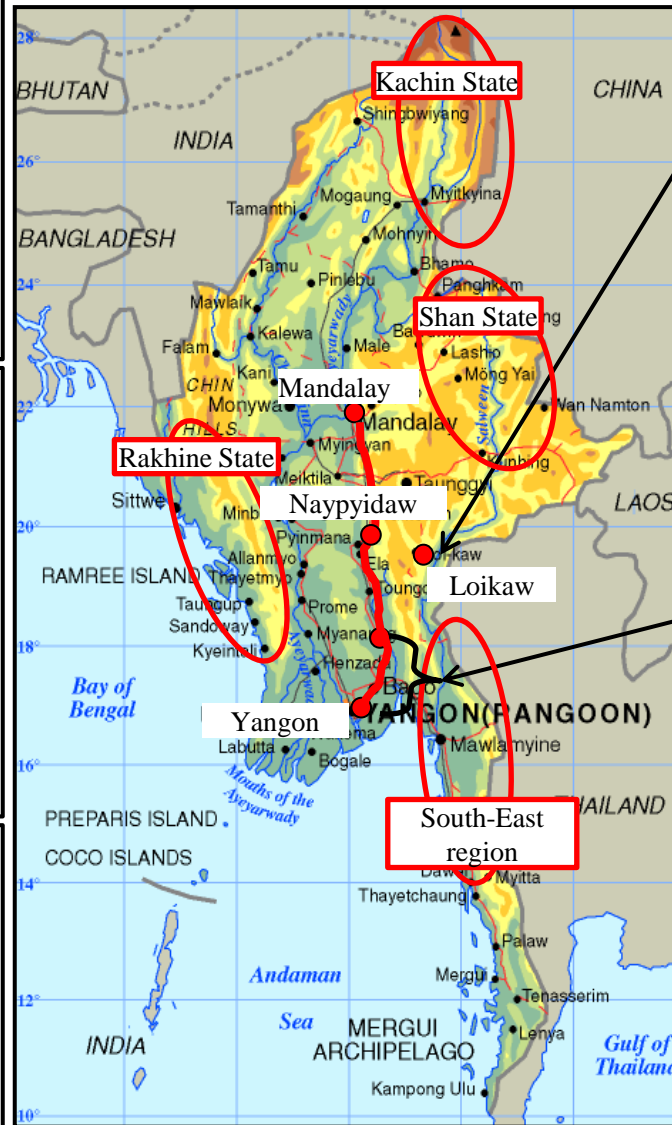
The Programme for Emergency Assistance to Displaced Children in Kachin and Rakhine (in cooperation with UNICEF)
(Up to JPY 300 million)

To provide medicines/nutritional supplements to displaced women and children and to enhance the water and sanitary systems



The Programme for Assistance to Displaced Persons in South-East of Myanmar, Rakhine, Kachin and Northern Shan States (in cooperation with UNHCR) **(Up to JPY 300 million)**

To provide/repair shelters in refugee camps and to provide guidance on operating and coordinating the camps



The Project for Improving Loikaw General Hospital in Kayah State
(Up to JPY 1,945 billion)

To reconstruct and replace old facilities and equipment of a general hospital in Kayah State



The Project for Installation of Operation Control Center System and Safety Equipment **(Up to JPY 4 billion)**

To install an centralized train monitoring system, electronic centralized interlocking equipment and rail crossing devices for part of a railway line between Yangon and Mandalay



The Food Security Project for Underprivileged Farmers
(Up to JPY 230 million)

To provide agricultural machines to the Agriculture Tractor Stations in local areas
